

# A1 | DAREBIN ART SALON

## TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Registrations Open: Monday 21 May 2018

Registrations Due: Thursday 5 July 2018, 5pm

Applications must be received online on or before this day.

Late entries will not be considered.

1. Entrants must be artists, creative practitioners or designers who live, work, study or base their creative practice in Darebin.
2. All works submitted must be original works by the artist whose name appears on the entry form and completed between 2016-2018.
3. All artworks must be no larger than A1 (59.4 x 84.1cm). They can be landscape or portrait in orientation.
4. Entry forms are to be submitted online via the Bundoora Homestead Art Centre website. If you need assistance, you may visit the Gallery during opening hours for staff to assist you.
5. Entry to the Salon is free of charge.
6. Employees of Darebin City Council, Councillors and members of the Bundoora Homestead Board of Management are ineligible to enter the Salon.
7. Entrants must not post or deliver any support material for their entry.
8. Entrants can only submit one application per person.
9. Entrants can be of any age.
10. Bundoora Homestead Art Centre reserves the right to refuse an artwork should it be deemed offensive.

### EXHIBITION

11. Entrants' work must arrive at Bundoora Homestead Art Centre between 10am-5pm on Monday 30 July 2018.
12. Entrants' work must be suitably framed and ready to hang or otherwise prepared for display. Works must be fitted with D-rings so that it can be hung on wires. Alternatively, it needs to be light enough that it can be stuck to the walls using 3M/magnets. If works are still wet, they will not be accepted.
13. Works must be labelled with the artist's name and title of work.
14. Any works damaged in transit or without an appropriate hanging system will not be presented for judging.
15. All selected works must be available for display throughout the duration of the exhibition.
16. The gallery staff will install selected artworks at their discretion.
17. A launch event will be held on Saturday 11 August at 2pm. All entrants are encouraged to attend. Prizes will be announced at the launch event.

### SALES

18. No commission on sales is taken. The Gallery will collect interested buyers' contact details and forward the information through to the Artist - it is the Artist's responsibility to process artwork sales and hand over sold artworks to the buyer.

### INSURANCE

19. Darebin City Council covers insurance for the artworks for any loss or damage suffered to any work in its possession. Entrants should ensure their work is insured for couriering/transporting to and from Bundoora Homestead Art Centre.

### **FREIGHT**

20. Freight costs must be paid by the artist, entries will not be received by Council unless freight has been paid in full. No payment will be made by Council for freight or any other charge incurred in the delivery and/or return of any work submitted.

### **REPRODUCTION OF WORKS**

21. Copyright of the artwork remains the property of the entrant. Entrants specifically permit and authorise Council to reproduce his or her art work by print or electronic/social media for publicity purposes, reports, catalogues and any other publications related to the Darebin Art Salon for a period of five years from the closing date of the exhibition. Due attribution will be made to the artist.

### **PRIZES TBC**

22. One exhibiting artist will be awarded the opportunity to present a solo exhibition of works at Bundoora Homestead Art Centre in 2019-2020. Judging for this award will include one independent expert from the art sector in Victoria and the Bundoora Homestead Art Centre Curator. The judging panel shall solely determine the prizewinning entry. However the judging panel and Council reserve the right not to award the prize. The exhibition may be offered in any one of the various gallery spaces at Bundoora Homestead Art Centre at the discretion of the Curator.

23. A People's Choice Award will be awarded at the close of the exhibition to the artist who receives the most votes from visitors to the exhibition. They will be awarded a small prize.

24. The judges may elect to highly commend works which may also be awarded a small prize.

### **COLLECTION OF WORKS**

25. The exhibition will close on Sunday 16 September 2018. Entries are to be collected from Bundoora Homestead Art Centre on either Monday 17 September or Tuesday 18 September during the hours 10am-5pm. If works have not been collected by 5pm Tuesday 18 September 2018 Council reserves the right to dispose of the works.
