TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

DAREBIN ART PRIZE 2019 | \$10,000

A biennial national multi-medium acquisitive art prize awarding excellence in contemporary visual art.

Entries Due: 5 July 2019, 5pm

Applications must be received online on or before this day/time. Late entries will not be considered.

1. Artists must be an Australian citizen or permanent resident residing primarily in Australia.
2. The prize-winning entry shall become Council property upon payment of prize money to the winning artist.
3. All works submitted for the Award must be original works by the artist whose name appears on the entry form, and completed between 2017 and 2019.
4. By entering this prize, the artist agrees that to the best of their knowledge their artwork does not infringe on the copyright of anyone else.
5. Artists must submit with this entry form:
 - A non-refundable handling fee of \$30
 - A one-page Curriculum Vitae
 - An artist's statement about the work (up to 150 words)
 - A full image of the actual work being submitted for judging the Award

The image must be a high resolution (300 dpi) JPG digital file. Up to two images may be submitted but one of these must represent the artwork in its entirety. The file size of image is not to exceed 5mb. PowerPoint and/or PDF files are NOT acceptable. Video artworks are to be submitted online only: please provide a link to a webpage for your video to be reviewed and provide video link password if required. The video work in its entirety must be viewable. A still image of the video is required as well.

6. File names are to be in the following format:

7. Entries are to be submitted online via the Bundoora Homestead Art Centre webpage. If you require support in submitting online or have access needs please contact gallery staff on 03 9496 1060.
8. Employees of Darebin City Council, Councillors and members of the Bundoora Homestead Art Centre Board of Management are ineligible to enter the prize.
9. Previous Darebin Art Prize finalists or artists with works in the Darebin Art Collection are

welcome to apply.

10. Additional support material that is not requested will not be accepted or returned.
11. There is a limit of two entries per person. A non-refundable payment of \$30 including GST is applicable to each artwork entered. A receipt will be issued for each entry. Please note that only one artwork per artist will be selected for exhibition.
12. Works that can't be lifted by two people will not be accepted.
13. The artwork details entered on the Darebin Art Prize entry form are final and no changes can be made.

PRE-SELECTION

14. A pre-selection committee including the Curator of Bundoora Homestead Art Centre will select the finalists. Due to the number of entries received for the Darebin Art Prize, only artworks chosen as finalists will be exhibited.
15. Please note, no substitutes for works entered will be accepted and no correspondence will be entered into once the decision is reached and applicants have been notified.
16. If your work is unusually large or complex please discuss your application with the Curator before submitting, via bundoorahomestead@darebin.vic.gov.au.
17. Selection Criteria for finalists (and winning work) is as follows:
 - 30%: Contributes to the goals of Bundoora Homestead Art Centre and of the Darebin Council, in particular to foster inspiration, celebration and encourage the Arts to thrive, entertain, and delight.
 - 25%: Artistic innovation and originality
 - 25%: Technical skill
 - 20%: Aligns with goals and purpose of Darebin Art Collection

EXHIBITION

18. Finalists' work must arrive at Bundoora Homestead Art Centre between 10am-5pm from Wednesday 28 August –Sunday 1 September 2019.
19. Finalists' work must be suitably framed and ready to hang or otherwise prepared for display and be labelled with the artist's name, address and title of work.
20. Any works damaged in transit or without an appropriate hanging system will not be presented for final judging.
21. Should Council identify an OH&S or legal risk in the work, Council reserves the right to request a different work by the finalist, or to undertake an independent analysis of the work to ensure it poses no risk to Council. Should a different work not be available Council reserves the right to retract the offer to the artist being presented as a finalist.
22. All selected works must be available for display throughout the duration of the exhibition.
23. All artworks must be available to be acquired for the Darebin Art Collection, if selected as the winning artwork. For artworks available for sale, no commission on sales is taken. Bundoora Homestead Art Centre is not responsible for handling sales. Should there be an interested buyer, queries will be forwarded onto the artist or a representative of the artist.
24. The date of birth of Darebin Art Prize Finalists will be displayed on the artwork label.

JUDGING

25. The panel of judges for the Award will be composed of two independent selectors from the Australian visual art sector and a staff member from Bundoora Homestead Art Centre.
26. The judging panel shall solely determine the prizewinning entry. However the judging panel and Council reserve the right not to award the prize.

27. The judging panel's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into. (See Point 17. for Judging Criteria.)

INSURANCE

28. Darebin City Council covers insurance for the artworks for any loss or damage suffered to any work while in its possession. Finalists should ensure their work is insured for courtering to and from Bundoora Homestead Art Centre.

FREIGHT

29. Entries will not be received by Council unless free of charge. No payment will be made by Council for freight or any other charge incurred in the delivery and/or return of any work submitted. Artists are responsible for their own freight.

REPRODUCTION OF WORKS AND STATEMENTS

30. Copyright of the artwork remains the property of the entrant. Finalists specifically permit and authorise Council to reproduce their work and artist's statement by print or electronic/social media for publicity purposes, reports, catalogues and any other publications related to the Darebin Art Prize for a period of five years from the closing date of the exhibition. Due attribution will be made to the artist.
31. The winner of the major acquisitive prize will grant Darebin Council a non-exclusive, perpetual copyright license to reproduce the work for non-commercial purposes in electronic and print material. Darebin Council will attribute the Artist as the author of the work wherever the work is reproduced.

COLLECTION OF WORKS

32. The exhibition will close on Sunday 26 January 2020. Entries, other than the prize-winning entry, are to be collected from Bundoora Homestead Art Centre on either Tuesday 28 January or Wednesday 29 January, 2020 during the hours 10am-5pm.
33. If an artist does not collect their work on the allocated collection dates, they will be charged \$200 a week for storage and after two weeks, their work may be disposed of.
